Excuses run out when Physician leaves comfort zone to mentor challenged child

The excuses to keep me from mentoring a child at Southeastern Children's Home were endless. It would have been easy to avoid the uncomfortable opportunity presented to me, to have found something else to do with my time.

I was pleasantly surprised when I first met Bobby, a teenage victim of a foster system that bounces children from one home to another and then expects these same children to form relationships and act like members of the Cleaver family.

That's not how Bobby acts.

Not even close.

He is, however, kind, considerate and starving for a better life. Sure, he embellishes his situation, or downright lies about his circumstances. He copes the best way he can.

You may think I'm making excuses for Bobby. I'm not. Doing so would go against everything I do in my current job as an emergency

physician. Every day, I walk through the doors of the hospital and help people address the disasters they often have created for themselves.

Bobby, however, didn't ask to be a foster child. He didn't ask to be born of two parents who were not capable of resolving conflict. He didn't ask for his father to be incarcerated and generally despicable. He, in short, didn't, initially bring all of this on himself.

I purposefully don't ask about Bobby's past. I listen to him. I help him address his interactions in a forgiving and caring way. I pray for wisdom and discernment to help Bobby

not 'waller in the mud' of his previous mistakes. I pray to God that I provide a good, consistent and caring example of what Jesus is to me... Love Personified.

In Jonah 3:10, God forgives the Ninevites. I'm amused at Jonah's response. To paraphrase, Jonah says, "I knew you'd be gracious so go ahead and kill me because life is not worth living."

This just stuns me. This passage exemplifies a God of grace and simultaneously gives us a poor response to God's calling.

Do we treat those that have the greatest emotional and physical needs the same way Jonah treated the Ninevites? Are we too afraid to the leave the comforts of our suburban homes and families to help young men and women like Bobby? Like Jonah, do we avoid uncomfortable opportunities?

Being a mentor has been uncomfortable. I've never done anything like this. Occasionally, there are awkward moments. I don't always know the best way to respond. There are challenges for which I'm ill-equipped. I've chosen to embrace and pray over these inadequacies and see the benefit in my own life. I pray that in some small way Bobby and the other children at Southeastern will benefit as well.

I encourage each of you to strongly consider supporting Southeastern financially and with your time.
