Hoop diaries: win or lose, Senn Cottage girls invited to play church-league basketball

Everyone should have the opportunity to play on a team. There's a lot to be learned through organized athletics: the importance of practice & hard work; breaking a rule of the game has unavoidable consequences; and perhaps most importantly, you're not just part of a team, you're part of a family.

This past year our girls in the Senn cottage were invited to play on a church-league basketball team hosted by one of our local congregations.

"We were thrilled to have the girls from the children's home play on our team," coach Will Hammond said. "We wanted the children's home girls to feel like part of our church family, not just be a part of our Sunday school and Wednesday night classes."

This is only the second year the Coyotes have fielded a team, and only the first year that we've had girls from the children's home interested in playing.

"Basketball served as a great way for the children's home girls to get closer to the rest of our church family," Coach Hammond said. "It's pretty common for girls from the children's home to be reserved and shy. Who can blame

them? If I were put in a similar situation, I'd be reluctant too. But, on the court, everyone becomes a family."

The girls didn't exactly light up the scoreboard when they first began playing with the team.

"We lost one game 3-2," Coach Hammond said. "Even though the girls had extensive experience shooting the basketball at home, they hadn't played organized basketball before. Let's just say there was a lot of raw talent."

"I just liked being taught new things," Hailey said. "The coaches were great. They would teach us techniques and help us discover what you can and can't do. I even learned how to shoot a three-pointer."

The coaches were all impressed with the development of the girls through the season.

"All of the girls scored at least once," Coach Hammond said. "That's a good feeling as coach, but points aren't the most important thing; family is."
