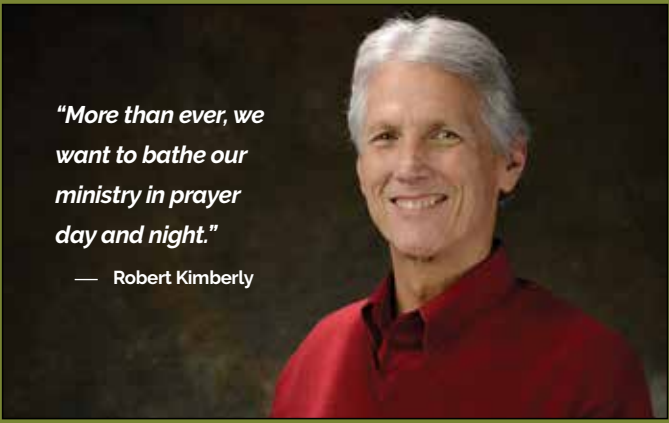
It's a season of change for us at Southeastern Children's Home and Counseling Center.

In October, twelve of our residents spent a day summiting Table Rock Mountain in Pickens County. For many of our children, this was their first chance to climb a mountain.

"The longest I've ever had to walk was a mile," 16-yr old Senn Cottage resident Erin said. "And that was during a P.E. class. This was a six and a half mile grueling hike up and down a mountain with rocks. Just when you think you had reached the top, you'd see another bend in the trail. I thought we'd never get to the top, but we did... eventually."

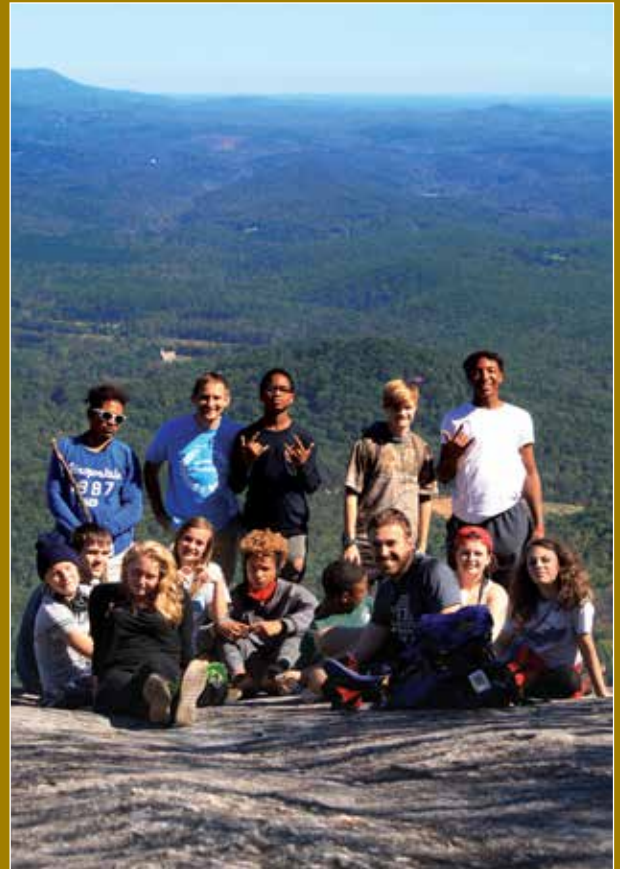
Several within the group were encouraging and helpful. The group certainly grew closer to each other during the day-long adventure.

"Dantonio was the best motivator," Erin said. "Not only would he keep me laughing, but he would not let me stop. That's the kind of person you want beside you when things are tough. It was great because we stuck together and everyone cheered everyone else on."

Some of our kids were astonished by the view at the summit.

"I've never been to the top of a mountain before," 14-year old Senn cottage resident Kylie said. "I've lived all my life in South Carolina, and today was the first day I've been able to see a view like this."

Overall, the trip was a huge success. The children enjoyed the experience and many were able to find a deeper meaning to the trip.

Jade's work ethic shines as she strives for independence

One job is usually enough for anyone, but Jade isn't just anyone.

Jade, a 17-year old Senn cottage resident, recently received her GED and is working two different jobs as she prepares to be independent.

"We're so proud of Jade," Housedad Steve Davis said. "She has two jobs: one as a waitress at Cracker Barrel, and one as a barista at Starbucks. She's the hardest working child we've ever had."

If having two jobs wasn't enough, she uses her spare time to volunteer at the local humane society.

"I can't stand still," Jade said. "I need to be active. I have to have a job that keeps me moving. One job just wasn't enough."

In addition to earning an income, Jade is also learning life lessons on how to interact with people.

"Not only is she earning money, she's learning how to work with a team of people. She's learning to submit to authority," Steve said. "Plus, she's learning to get along with people of all ages, not just kids her own age. Jade is a very caring child. Just the other day she saw an elderly lady crossing the street and she rushed over to help her. Then, Jade gave this stranger \$15 of her own money. I couldn't have been more proud."

"Working as waitress has its ups and downs," Jade said. "Most people don't understand that I only get paid \$2.13 an hour as a server. Plus, it gets taxed! But I love interacting with the customers."

Jade, who is starting college in January, is currently saving up to purchase a car and have enough money for a deposit on an apartment.

"I'm just hoping to be able to afford a dependable car," Jade said. "I don't need anything fancy. I just need something that gets me from point A to point B."

"She wants to be out on her own when she turns 18 in May," Steve said. "She's already saved over a \$1000. One of the hardest parts of being a dad is letting go. We'll be sad when she leaves us, but we're proud of all that she's done to prepare for the next chapter in life."
